

[Sequoia Shuttle Fact Sheet]

What is It?

- An environmentally-friendly mode of transportation to, from, and within the Sequoia National Park.
- A partnership between the City of Visalia and the National Parks Service.
- Service is provided Memorial Day through Labor Day.
- 3-year demonstration project (2007-2009).

What will it do?

- Provide easy-to-use transportation from Downtown Visalia to locations throughout Sequoia National Parks
- Enhance transportation options to Sequoia National Park.
- Eliminates the distraction and hassle of traffic congestion and crowded parking lots.

Shuttle Details

- Operates seven days a week from Downtown Visalia up to the Giant Forest Museum in Sequoia National Park.
- Travel from Visalia to the park entrance will take approximately 2 hours.
- Internal park travel will vary from 15 to 30 minutes.
- Destinations include the Giant Forest Museum, Moro Rock, Lodgepole Visitor Center and Campground, Crescent Meadow, and Wuksachi Village.
- Travelers will enjoy comfortable seats and an educational video about the National Parks.
- Each shuttle is equipped with ample room for luggage storage.
- Tickets can be purchased as part of local lodging packages or separately for \$10-15.
- Purchase tickets via the Internet, phone, and locations throughout Visalia.
